





School Timings and Routines

School Timings and Routines

- P1 students are dismissed from Main Gate 1 or Gate 3 (near MRT station) if their parents/ caregivers are picking them up. Students cannot go home on their own.
- On the First Day of School (2 January 2024), please allow our children to go through the actual dismissal process so that they can be independent right from the start of the school year.

2 Jan – 5 Jan (Term 1 Week 1)	7.30 am	1.00 pm
From 8 Jan ¹ (Term 1 Week 2)	7.30 am	1.30 pm

¹ Recess time is from 8.45 am to 9.15 am

- Students to report to school by 7.30 am on every school day. A student who arrives after 7.30 am is considered late.
- We seek our parents' co-operation to ensure our students attend school daily and punctually.
- Students who are absent from school need to have a medical certificate or other valid official documents.
- Parents are to inform their children's Form Teachers (e.g., via Class Dojo app) if their children are absent on that day.

Hairstyles and Appearance for Boys


Boys

- Students must be neat in appearance and clean shaven.
- Hair must be evenly trimmed, short and neat without use of gel.
- Hair must not touch the eyebrows, ears or collar.
- Long fringes and/ or long sideburns are not allowed.
- Inappropriate or outlandish hairstyles are not allowed (e.g., spiky, undercut, mohawk cut, bushy or coloured hair is prohibited).

Hairstyles and Appearance for Girls

Girls

- Hair must be kept clean, neat and tidy.
- Hair is to be kept away from the face.
- Hair must be neatly tied up if they touch the top of the collar.
- Long fringes (extend below eyebrows) must be pinned or tied up.
- Only black hair band/ ribbon/ rubber band/ clip is allowed.
- Inappropriate or outlandish hairstyles and coloured hair are not allowed.

Use of Mobile Device and Smart Watch

Use of Mobile Device and Smart Watch

- The school discourages students to bring their mobile devices.
- Students are to take full responsibility for the use and safekeeping of their mobile phones and/ or smart device(s).
- Mobile phones must be switched off and placed in school bags, at all times during school hours.
- Use of mobile phones by students is restricted to outside of school campus for the purpose of communication with parents/ caregivers for dismissal arrangements only.
- Students are not allowed to use the mobile phones or smart devices to record, transmit or post photos or video of a person or persons on school campus.

Use of Mobile Device and Smart Watch

- Images or video recorded at school must not be transmitted or posted at any time without the permission of a teacher.
- Students who are found to have been engaged in inappropriate use of mobile devices, outside the permissible time and place, will be subjected to disciplinary action(s); e.g., confiscation.
- The form teacher or another staff member will contact the parent to make arrangements to collect the mobile phone and/or smart device from the General Office if necessary.
- Parents who wish to contact their children during curriculum hours can call our General Office.

Nails and Accessories

Nails and Accessories

- Fingernails must be short, clean and unpainted.
- No items of personal adornment, jewellery (e.g., anklet, ring, pendant, friendship band) or expensive watches should be worn to school.
- Girls are allowed to wear only a pair of simple ear studs (in silver, black or white and not more than 5mm in diameter).
- Henna and tattoo stickers are not allowed in school.
- Only plain and mono-coloured jackets/ sweaters with minimal design can be worn in school. Students will be asked to remove their jackets/ sweaters if deemed inappropriate.

Important Information for Parents

Administrative Matters

- Timetable will be given out by 5 January 2024 (Friday). Please help your child pack the learning materials to bring according to the timetable.
- The current orientation group (1A to 1F) is NOT the class that your child will be in for 2024. The school will share another update once your child's class has been confirmed by the end of January 2024.
- Please ensure that all your child's belongings and learning materials are clearly labelled with his/her name. Due to safety issue, the school discourages our students from carrying trolley bags (see sample picture below) to school.
- Parents can only buy books and school attire after 1.00 pm on 2
 January and after 2.00 pm from 3 January onwards.


