2	GIRO and Edusave sign- up for School	GIRO Application School fees are deducted via GIRO. Parents will be able to apply for GIRO online for payment of school fees and charges from 26 Nov 2022. The link will be available through Parents Gateway (PG) app and in the MOE internet website (School fees MOE). Parents will have up till 15 Jan 2023 to sign up for GIRO for the first deduction in Feb 2023. The new digital service is available to account holders from BOC, DBS/POSB, MAY, OCBC, SCB, HSBC and UOB. Edusave Standing Order (Online) All Singapore Citizen students will have an Edusave account automatically opened for them and receive a yearly contribution. Parents can apply to use Edusave funds for payment of the 2nd tier miscellaneous fees and enrichment programmes via Parents Gateway (under Services tab) or the online Edusave Standing Order Form





HOW is learning organised in Punggol View Primary School ...

PGVP School Hours for 2024...

Curriculum starts: 7.30 a.m.

- ❖ Different timing for 1st 3 days especially for P1
- Day 1, 2 and 3 report at 8 am; Purpose to synchronise with other levels....
- All students must be in school uniform
- Your child has the option of wearing /not wearing mask as guided by national posture; If not well, good to wear mask.

Day 4 (5 Jan) onward- Reporting time is at 7.25 am . Same as other levels.



In a nutshell: First Day of School...

- Only P1 and K1 students and parents will be in school on 2 Jan 2024... (Day 1 of school for P1 students)
- Report at 8.00 am ... students will proceed to the canteen where a teacher will bring your child up to the classroom
- Parents to register at the canteen before proceeding to designated room for Interaction with P session
- Join recess Get the chance to see your child having recess
- Parent Workshop in the designated room after recess...

- Would like all parents to be on board.





Dismissal @ IBC....



- Dismissal for 1st day (12.30) and the rest of Week 1- 1 pm
- Students will dismissed at the Backgate. Parents will wait at the backgate ensuring safe distancing is observed.
- Others will be assembled at the IBC. They will be grouped into the following dismissal points
