



- Absence from CCA is a serious offence-Skipping of Lessons
- Not eligible for any school-based or MOE Awards if conduct grade is Poor or Fair
- You will be notified when your child/ward is absent on day of CCA.


KEEPING IN TOUCH WITH THE SCHOOL






